HEAR: FOCUS FOR 0-4 YEARS OLD

OBJECTIVE: Tell kids about the foundational building blocks of the Christian faith.

Volunteers will help kids hear about:

What is the Bible?

Who is God?

Who is Jesus?

What is man?

What is sin?

What is the gospel?

What are disciples?

SEE: FOCUS FOR PRE-K- 2ND GRADE

OBJECTIVE: Show how and why the gospel connects to everyday life.

Volunteers will show kids:

What is in the Bible?

What does the Bible say about God?

What does the Bible say about Jesus?

What is repentance?

What is following Jesus?

What is worship?

What is a Gospel Community?

ASK: FOCUS FOR 3RD-4TH GRADE

OBJECTIVE: Teach and enable kids to ask meaningful questions about God, the gospel, faith, and themselves.
Volunteers will enable kids to ask questions like:

Why can the Bible be trusted?

Why does God reveal certain things about Himself?

Why is Jesus so important?

Why does the local church exist?

Why does the local church connect people to Gospel Communities?

What is so good about the gospel?

PROCESS: FOCUS FOR 5TH-8TH GRADE

OBJECTIVE: Teach and enable kids to process the major tenets and implications of the gospel in everyday life.

Volunteers will lead kids to process questions like:

How do I process what the Bible says?

How do I process the world around me?

How do I process who I am and what I am becoming?

How do I process what God has done and is doing?

How do I process the gospel?

How do I participate in a Gospel Community?

PARTICIPATE: FOCUS FOR 9TH- 12TH GRADE

OBJECTIVE: Empower and equip Students to participate in the local church.

Volunteers will help students understand and be able to explain:

What does it mean to be part of a local church?

What is the role of the local church in my life?
